

HOW TO SECURE A SHIPPING CONTAINER



HEAVY DUTY PADLOCKS

Heavy-duty padlocks are made with hardened steel and are resistant to prying, sawing and rusting. It is difficult to cut them using bolt-cutters.

LOCK BOXES

Lock boxes make it very difficult to cut the padlocks. They can be welded or bolted onto the container. They stop thieves from cutting through or forcing open your padlock.



INNER BOLTS

Inner bolts are used to lock doors from inside the [shipping container](#). It is impossible to get rid of them if someone is not inside of the container.

CROSSBAR LOCKS

Crossbar locks prevent the handles of the primary door from turning. They are available as portable locks and it is not necessary to weld them.



ALARM SYSTEMS

Standard alarm systems or GSM alarms can be installed depending on the container's location. These customized alarms consist of features such as sensors, motion detectors, and closed-circuit TV for monitoring purposes.
